

The 2011 revised English translation of the post-Vatican II Roman Missal, has been in use in the United States since the First Sunday of Advent 2011. With the exception of the *Pater Noster* and *Agnus Dei*, however, the Latin texts of the Mass are not provided in the new English-language Missal (as they were in previous editions). This makes it difficult for priests who might wish to alternate freely between Latin and English.

The St. Gregory Foundation for Latin Liturgy and Ignatius Press have collaborated to produce a Latin supplement to the English-language Roman Missal. It is available in two sizes (standard altar edition and a smaller, "chapel" edition). This 45-page supplement contains the entire Ordinary of the Mass in Latin (with chants), and a generous selection of Prefaces. It is designed to be inserted at the back of the Altar Missal by means of adhesive strips, and comes with tabs to mark the Eucharistic Prayers and other key sections of the Mass.
